

SOUTH CENTRAL COOP STORAGE CHARGES EFFECTIVE 9/1/18

STORAGE:

CORN-OATS-SOYBEANS: Minimum charge of .17 per bushel for the first 123 days and .00175 per bushel per day thereafter.

Storage charges will be due when grain is sold or billed each year to individual accounts before the close of the fiscal year on August 31st, whichever comes first.

Corn moisture to 14%

GRAIN BANK:

CORN-OATS: NO Storage for the first 60 days and .00175 per bushel per day thereafter billed to individual accounts each month end.

All corn or oats sold from grain bank or delivered as whole grain will be charged an additional .17 per bushel.

To qualify for grain bank storage corn or oats must be mixed in a feed ration or run through our mill and are subject to grinding and mixing charges.

Corn moisture to 14%

PRICED LATER CORN OR BEANS:

Flat .14 per bushel from September 1st through February 28th.

Flat .02 per bushel from March 1st through August 20th.

(If February 28 or August 20 lands on a day when markets are not open then pricing will occur at the close of the next marketing day)

Corn moisture to 15%

RECEIVING:

Corn-Oats-Soybeans-Truck lots .10 per bushel.

LOADING OUT:

Corn-Oats-Soybeans-Truck lots .10 per bushel.

Receiving and load out charges totaling .20 per bushel are assessed only if grain is loaded out for account of the depositor. No receiving or load out charges shall be made on stored products when purchased by the warehouseman.

SHRINK

Corn= Points of moisture removed
X .1.50 % (1.25 water + .25 handling)
X wet bushels = shrink
